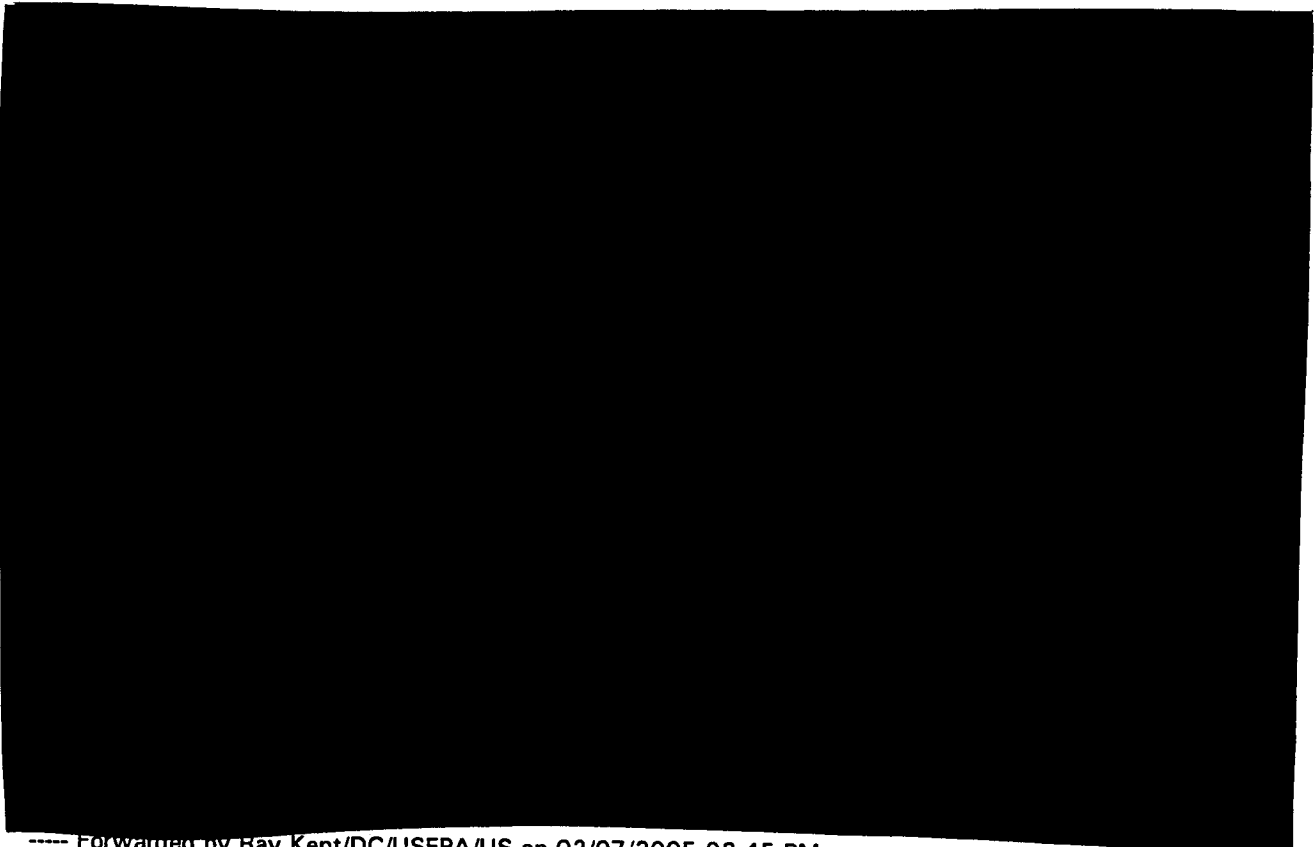

Subject Phosphine Tox



As you may recall from our technical meeting with the phosphine coalition there were a number of tox angles that were discussed in terms of possible ways to convince us to reevaluate the 10X factors. Can you give me a feel for which, if any, of these approaches you believe might be reasonable. In other words, which, if any, would be a waste of time and resources on the part of the coalition since they are extremely unlikely to have an impact on the factors? The approaches were:

- Using literature studies (rats, mice, turkeys, etc.) to establish a claim that the variability between species does not warrant a 10X
- categorical regression work using dosimetric adjustments proposed by Betty Anderson
- review of human epi studies (we have the study OSHA used and there is at least one other study (Mishra? 1988) to establish a claim that the interspecies 10X is not warranted

I think we will need to make a call on item three in any event so the real question concerns the other two approaches, especially the categorical regression idea. Please let me know ASAP. Thanks.
